Dear Mr. Mike Tannura,

Strong t-storms are in progress across the northern Delta. Thus far, best totals have occurred to the west of concentrated soybean production. Use this link for radar-estimated totals from last night through 9:45 AM Central Time: <http://www.tstorm.net/weather/radar.gif> . Note dark blue is 0.60"+; green is 1.00"+.

Our analysis suggest the best totals should remain across western Kentucky and northeast Arkansas with local 1.00" totals. Some t-storms will occur further to the south this afternoon, but most areas will only receive near- to lower-than-average 5-day totals from this event. A poor wind field across Mississippi and Alabama should prevent this t-storm cluster from progressing far into those states (winds are pointed away from the t-storms; t-storms tend to fade if winds are not pointed toward the t-storms).
