The latest GFS is complete through Thursday night. It develops a few showers and t-storms across the eastern Corn Belt, but significant rainfall remains unlikely. Therefore, beyond any rain today, the next chance for rain across the eastern Corn Belt does not exist until late next week and significant totals are not expected. The Delta should remain dry for next week.
